The petitioner claims to have Hawker licence No.2786 since the year 1991 and he is statedly registered for allotment of booth at registration No.3522. The Hawker licence was granted to the petitioner under the 'Hand Cart Bye-laws' formulated by U.T. Chandigarh. The Chandigarh Administration later on formulated a Scheme known as 'Allotment/Transfer of Built Up Booths in Any Sector on Lease/Hire Purchase Basis in Chandigarh Rules, 1991'. Under these Rules, built-up booths are allotted to the registered licencees of Hand Cart/Hawkers working in various Rehri Markets. The petitioner's case is that he is also working in Rehri Market, Sector-39, Chandigarh where he set-up a *khokha* which the Municipal authorities have suddenly removed in April, 2017. The claim of the petitioner for allotment of booth under the 1991 Rules/Scheme has not been decided so far though he had applied in the prescribed format and with requisite amount. The petitioner thereafter represented the authorities for allotment of the booth but finding no response thereto, the instant writ petition has been filed.

view the nature of relief sought by him but without expressing any views on his entitlement, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Estate Officer, U.T. Chandigarh to consider and decide the above-mentioned claim of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. Let a copy of the writ petition be also sent alongwith certified copy of this order for consideration of the Estate Officer, U.T. Chandigarh.
