Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Nidhi Garg, AAG, Haryana,
accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

The petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to regularize
her services w.e.f. 27.02.2004 instead of 25.08.2014 at par with her junior
namely Mohinder Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has
been working as peon in Government Middle School, Badya Rangran,
Tehsil & District Hisar. Initially, she was appointed as part time Sweeper-
cum-Mali on 21.08.1990 against sanctioned post. However, her services
were not regularized as per policy (Annexure P-4). Eventually, she has
been regularized w.e.f. 25.08.2014. Learned counsel has referred to the
case of one Mohinder Singh, who has been regularized w.e.f. 30.06.2003
with all consequential benefits as per policy dated 27.02.2004. His
appointment letter is annexed as Annexure P-6.

Grievance of the petitioner is that she should be regularized at par with his junior w.e.f. 27.02.2004 instead of 25.08.2014. The petitioner has since retired on 30.06.2018.

In view of the above fact, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to look into the representation/legal notices of the petitioner dated 15.03.2018 & 20.05.2018 (Annexures P-11 & P-12) and pass appropriate speaking order(s) in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
