The land of the petitioner situated within the revenue estate of Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar was statedly acquired vide Award dated 24.04.1998. The petitioner is said to have applied on 23.03.2017 for allotment of plot under the Oustees Policy in lieu of the acquisition of her land. Since no action appears to have been on her application and her claim regarding allotment of plot under the Oustees Policy is still under consideration, the instant writ petition has been filed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any views on the merits of her claim, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to ascertain the correct facts and decide the petitioner's claim as contained in the legal notice dated 23.03.2017, in accordance with the HUDA Policy within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
