It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that despite the order of warrant of possession having been issued by the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Giddarbaha, on 14.03.2016 (Annexure P-4), after the finalization of partition proceedings between the parties, till date the possession has not been handed over to the petitioner. Highlighting this aspect, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 08.06.2018 (Annexure P-5), followed by a legal notice dated 04.07.2018 (Annexure P-6) through counsel addressed to Tehsildar, Tehsil Gidarbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, but no response/action has been taken by the said respondent. Counsel, thus, contends that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to consider the representation dated 08.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take decision thereon within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Gidarbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and Tehsildar, Estate Office, Giddarbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, -respondent Nos.2 and 3 respectively to consider and decide the representation dated 08.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
