Though the petitioners' claim for allotment of plots under the Oustees Category has been acknowledged by the Estate Officer, HUDA, Panipat vide speaking order dated 22.03.2017 (P-11), yet no allotment has been made on the premise that they are required to apply again as per the new policy.

It may be mentioned here that the land of petitioners situated within the revenue estate of Village Taraf Afgan, Panipat, measuring 34 kanals 14 marlas was acquired vide Award No.4 dated 11.04.2014 for Sector-29, Part-2, Industrial Units, Panipat. They thus fall under the category of Oustees. After the Estate Officer, HUDA, Panipat passed the order dated 22.03.2017 (P-11) acknowledging the petitioners' claim for allotment of plots under the Oustees Category, they have again represented on 10.05.2018 for making actual allotment.

Meanwhile, the State Government has taken a new policy decision on 24.05.2018 whereunder the petitioners have become eligible to seek allotment of plots/booths under the Oustees quota. In view of that

Policy decision, this Court vide order dated 18.07.2018 disposed of a bunch of writ petition including CWP No.7786 of 2015 (Raj Kumar versus State of Haryana and others), observing as follows:-

“ Learned counsel for Marketing Board and Market Committee, Panipat has filed an affidavit of Secretary-cum-Executive Officer, Market Committee, Panipat dated 16.07.2018 to the effect that the State Government has taken a new policy decision on 24.05.2018 accepting the proposal sent by the Board, whereunder the oustees like the petitioners have also become eligible to seek allotment of plots/booths under the Oustees quota. In pursuance to the aforesaid Government decision, a communication dated 29.06.2018 has been issued inviting applications from the oustees like the petitioners so that their claim for allotment can be considered. It has rendered the grievance of the petitioners as infructuous.....”

Let the applications from the petitioners or such other oustees be also invited in terms of the above-stated policy, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order and fate of such applications be decided within three months thereafter.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
