The impugned order has been passed by an officer in the rank of Estate Officer. There are other superior authorities in the hierarchy, i.e., Administrator or Chief Administrator, HUDA, who can equally redress the grievances of the aggrieved persons like the petitioner.

The writ petition is thus disposed of relegating the petitioner to avail the remedy of appeal-cum-representation before the Administrator/ Chief Administrator, HUDA, who in turn, are directed to decide the same by way of a reasoned order and also keeping in view the fact that the claim of the oustees cannot be kept pending for an endless period. Let the needful be done within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
