The petition stands disposed of in the same terms as in CWP No.16988 of 2018, *Tarsem Kumar Sharma v. State of Punjab and others* decided on July 13, 2018. In that case the following order was passed:-

“This petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the payment of Rs.4,02,110/- along with interest @18% per annum, qua the work, the petitioner and has been executed by the petitioner.

The petitioner was allotted the work, details of which have been mentioned in para No.3 of the petition. The petitioner has completed the said work, but the above said amount has not been released to him till date. In this regard, the petitioner has given a legal notice dated 31.05.2018 (Annexure P-3), but no action has been taken thereon till date.

In view of the above position, this petition, at this stage is disposed of without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, by giving a direction to respondents No. 3 and 4 to look in to the legal notice dated 31.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) of the

petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If respondent No. 3 and 4 come to a conclusion that the petitioner is entitled to the amount mentioned above, the same be released forthwith.”

The petitioner is common. The work order is different on which the claim for payment of money for work done is based on completion of work.

The petition stands disposed of in the same terms as in CWP No.16988 of 2018 and the legal notice dated May 31, 2018 will be decided within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
