The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing of the order dated 15.07.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by the District Revenue Officer-cum-Collector, Gurgaon whereby ex-parte proceedings had been initiated against the petitioner without serving any notice. Further prayer is for setting aside the mutation (Annexure P-2) vide No.3369 on the basis of the above order dated 15.07.2015.

After arguing for some time, counsel does not press the present writ petition and prays for liberty to agitate for his rights in accordance with law.

Resultantly, the present writ petition is dismissed as not pressed with the aforesaid liberty.
