This petition is filed for extension of parole on the ground that the father of the petitioner is suffering from cancer.

Earlier the petitioner had filed CWP No.3207 of 2018 for seeking parole for this purpose, which was granted on 04.04.2018 for a period of 3 weeks. The said period of parole was further extended for three weeks vide order dated 10.05.2018 passed in CM No.6090 of 2018 in CWP No.3207 of 2018. Thereafter, he again applied for parole, which was granted in CWP No.15377 of 2018 on 26.06.2018 for three weeks and the petitioner has to surrender on 22.07.2018.

It is apparent from the above facts and circumstances that the petitioner is repeatedly asking for extension of parole, whereas there is no cause for extending the parole time and again.

Consequently, the present petition is dismissed being denuded of any merit. However, the petitioner may, if so advised, again apply for parole in accordance with law, if there is a real necessity therefor.
