This petition is disposed of as per the directions issued by the Coordinate Bench in CWP No.14830 of 2017, *Ram Parsad and others v. State of Haryana* decided on December 20, 2017 whereby individual grievances would be redressed by the competent authority regarding re-fixation of pay in the wake of the notification dated November 21, 2017. Accordingly, the competent authority would act as per the notification within reasonable time. It is further directed that the delay in disposal of cases of this kind will result in saddling the State with 6% interest from three months of the date of the notification and thereafter at the enhanced rate of 9% will be borne by the officers/officials who delay re-fixation and actual payment. The State would have recovery rights against such erring officials.

The department should not be seen as transferring responsibility to this Court to deal with the present kind of litigation which should actually not come to the High Court.

With these observations and directions, the petition stands disposed of.
