Learned counsel for the respondents contended that the petitioner, herein, has already been promoted vide Annexure-R4 w.e.f. 01.07.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the claim of the petitioner is regarding his promotion from 2014 which he has pleaded in the writ petition itself. However, in view of the subsequent development having been taken place and order Annexure-R4, having been passed by the respondents' department, he seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the instant writ petition, with liberty to make representation before the respondents' department to consider his claim for promotion from 2014.

In view of above, the present writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the direction that if such representation is made before the respondents' department within a period of one month from today, the

respondents' department shall consider favourably and decide representation of the petitioner within a period of two months and if need be, the petitioner shall be at liberty to raise the same plea before this Court again.
