The petitioners have approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamas directing the respondent to regularise the loan account of the petitioners as they are ready and willing to pay the loan amount.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that a representation dated 21.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) had been filed with the respondent-bank but no decision thereon has so far been taken.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy of the case, we dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the respondent-bank to take a decision on the representation dated 21.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
