By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to produce the complete record of the case and to count his work charge service from 13.05.1968 to 22.02.1973 (approx. 04 years & 09 months) for the purpose of service and pensionary benefits WITH FURTHER to pay arrear on refixation of pay on account of his above said work charge service along with interest @ 18% p.a.

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2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide legal notice dated 01.04.2018 (P-4), in a time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated 01.04.2018 (P-4) and to decide the same, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. Further, the petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies as well as to approach this Court, in case, he still feels aggrieved against the order passed by the concerned authority.
