After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to official respondents to look into the grievance raised by the petitioner and decide the representations (Annexures P-2, P-4, P-5 & P-6) by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Ordered accordingly.
