The petitioner (Raj Kumar), had undertaken PSTET-II Test conducted in the year 2011, which is one of the mandatory qualifying test required for acquiring eligibility for appointment to the post of Teachers. The petitioner, who belongs to Backward Class Category and could not secure the minimum pass marks of 82 required for that category. In compliance to the orders passed by this Court in the year 2014/2015, grace marks were allotted to the candidates, who took the test in the year 2011 on account of some wrong answer keys. Accordingly, the petitioner's marks were upgraded from 82 to 83 and thereby he was declared pass in the PSTET-II Test conducted in the year 2011 vide notification dated 24.10.2017.

The present petition has been filed, seeking a writ of

mandamus for considering the petitioner for appointment to the post of Social Studies Teacher, advertised on 10.05.2011 based on the aforesaid revised result, as it is contended that the petitioner was wrongly held ineligible in the year 2011.

After arguing for sometime, realizing that no such relief can be legally claimed, therefore, counsel for the petitioner prays to withdraw the present writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
