The present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for directing the respondents to revise the pay scale of the petitioners w.e.f. 1.11.1971 instead of 16.7.1975 in view of the judgment dated 24.3.2009 (Annexure P-8) passed in CWP-2208 of 1989, titled as “Lekh Raj Khera and others vs. State of Punjab and another”.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the State submits that as per para 3 of the reply, the necessary relief sought by the petitioner has been allowed to them.

The relevant extract of the said para reads as under:-

“The claim of the petitioners as raised in the present writ petition has been considered in the light of decision dated 24.3.2009 (Annexure P-8) rendered by this Hon'ble Court in CWP No.2208 of 1989, “Lekh Raj Khera and others vs. State of Punjab and another”, the claim was

accepted by the District Education Officer (E.E.), Ludhiana and District Education Officer (S.E.) Jalandhar respectively. The petitioners have been granted pay scale of 220-12-340-15-400-20-500 w.e.f. 01.11.1971 or w.e.f. the date of their joining whichever was earlier.”

In this view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the grievance of the petitioners has been fully redressed and accordingly, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
