This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to take necessary action against respondent Nos. 3 and 4, who alleged to have been humiliating, misbehaving and threatening the petitioner with dire consequences at the police station.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been involved in a false case bearing FIR No.135 dated 30.05.2018, under Sections 21 of the Mining Act. In that case, he was directed to join investigation by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana. But, despite that he has not been allowed to join the investigation by respondent No.3. Pursuant to the bail and sapurdari orders, when the petitioner approached respondent Nos.3 and 4 for releasing his vehicles and joining the investigation, he was harassed, humiliated and beaten up by the aforesaid respondents. With regard to his grievance, petitioner has made a representation dated 04.07.2018 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2, but no

action has been taken thereon till date.

In view of the above position, this petition, at this stage is being disposed of without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, by giving a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look in to the application-representation dated 04.07.2018 (Annexure P-2) and take action in accordance with law.
