In the present writ petition, petitioner has sought for consideration of his name for appointment on compassionate ground. Undisputedly, Jagtar Singh- father of petitioner died way back in the year 2005. Petitioner submitted application for compassionate appointment only in the year 2011. Time and again Supreme Court has held that right to compassionate appointment is not a fundamental right. It is only with reference to social legislation. From 2005 to 2011 and even to this day petitioner's family was not suffering from hardship and the family was leading life. For the purpose of seeking compassionate appointment and its object is to meet immediate harness in the family. Harness in the family accrued in the present case way back in the year 2005. Therefore, petitioner has not made out any right to claim compassionate appointment in the year 2011 or as on today. Accordingly, CWP stands dismissed.
