Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition so as to enable the petitioner to move respondents No. 4 and 5, namely, Union of India and Secretary, Department of Sport and Youth Services, Punjab, respectively by filing detailed representation as regards the issues as also the grievances raised in this petition. He submits that in the event any such representation is indeed filed, the authorities be directed to deal therewith within a specified time.

2. Dismissed as withdrawn.
3. We are sanguine that in the event the petitioner moves respondents No. 4 and 5 and files representation, as indicated above, the authorities shall deal therewith and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the receipt of the said representation.
