Petitioner was appointed against the 2% posts reserved for the Wards of Police Personnel in the advertisement dated 29.09.2011 (P-2) whereby a general recruitment to the post of Constable was undertaken by the Punjab Police.

It is claimed that neither such Policy has been set aside by any Court of law nor there was any legal impediment for filling up the said posts reserved for the Police Personnel. It is claimed that now after three years a Show Cause Notice dated 13.7.2018 has been issued seeking to terminate the Petitioner on a false premise that there was no advertisement for filling up the posts under the 2% quota for the wards of Police Personnel.

After hearing Counsel for the petitioner, no case for interference against the impugned Show Cause Notice is made out at this stage as a detailed reply to the Show Cause notice concededly has

In view of the above, present petition is hereby dismissed as premature.
