The last candidate called for interview has secured 84 marks in General category for the post of Multi Purpose Health Worker (Male). The petitioners were not called for the interview because their marks were less than the last candidate who were called for interview the zone of consideration of which is twice the number of vacancies. The apprehension of the petitioners that they were declared ineligible for the post is misplaced since as per the statement of learned Law Officer the Commission has treated the petitioner as eligible but they were not called for interview as they failed to make the cut. Therefore, nothing remains to be adjudicated in this case on merits.

Accordingly, petition is dismissed.
