This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant continuity of service, without back wages, to the petitioner from the date of relieving till her reinstatement in service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that this benefit has already been granted to similarly situated employees vide orders (Annexures P-10 to P-21) and their pay has been re-fixed vide order(s) (Annexure P-22 to P-25).

With regard to her grievance, petitioner has served a legal notice dated 09.01.2018 (Annexure P-26) upon the respondents, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

In view of the above position, this petition, at this stage is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to look in to the legal notice dated 09.01.2018 (Annexure P-26) and pass appropriate orders regarding re-fixation of notional pay of the petitioner after granting the

benefit of continuity of service, without monetary benefit, in accordance with law, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
