Rajesh Bindal, J.

The petitioner filed the present petition, inter-alia praying for a direction to the respondents to allow her to participate in the Sub-Junior Girls' National Football Championship 2017-18. Validity of the eligibility conditions for players for Sub-Junior Girls' National Football Championship 2017-18 has also been challenged.

Learned counsel for respondent no. 2 submitted that the petitioner was allowed to participate in the tournament, which has now concluded. Hence, the relief prayed for by the petitioner does not survive. He further submitted that the eligibility conditions for each tournament are notified prior to the tournament. The prayer made in the writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Considering the fact that the petitioner had been allowed to participate in the tournament, which is now over, we dispose of the writ petition as infructuous, however, leaving the issue of validity of regulations open.
