1. A prayer made in the writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking Mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take and hand over the physical possession of the secured asset. A further direction is sought that application for appointment of receiver be disposed of after handing over the possession of the secured asset to the secured creditor.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the possession of the secured asset has been delivered to the petitioner on 20.8.2018 and, therefore, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
