The petitioner institute seeks affiliation of its institution which was denied simply on the ground that the petitioner institute was not equipped with the requisites of infrastructure and other related issues as per the norms prescribed by the respondents.

This fact is not disputed. We notice that report was submitted indicating such deficiencies.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however asserts that now all these deficiencies have been removed and the institute is fit for affiliation. He states that the petitioner intends to apply afresh considering that the affiliation period is alive for the next session.

If that be so, we are of the opinion that the pendency of the instant writ petition would not serve any purpose which has to be disposed of as having become infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

Before parting, we make it clear that in case the petitioner institute applies to the respondents for affiliation, the inspection of the institute shall be undertaken promptly by the respondents and in the eventuality of finding everything in order, necessary affiliation as a consequence be allowed.

Disposed of.

In view of the fact that the main case has been disposed of all the pending Civil miscellaneous applications also stand disposed of.
