JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Paramjit Singh) belongs to the Scheduled Caste Category and Handicapped Category and is working as a Patwari in the Revenue Department, Punjab. His grievance set out in the petition is that he has been denied to the promotion for the post of *Kanungo* on the ground that he has not cleared the refresher course, although he had already undertaken the refresher course at the time when his juniors have been promoted, but the result of the said course was not declared by the respondent-Department.

Upon notice, no reply has been filed.

Now a Civil Miscellaneous Application bearing **C.M. No. 2784 of 2018** has been filed by the counsel for petitioner, supported by petitioner's affidavit, whereby the petitioner has made a request for

unconditional withdrawal of the present writ petition.

In view of the contents of the aforesaid application
(CM No. 2784 of 2018), duly supported by the affidavit of the petitioner,
the same is **allowed**, the main writ petition is **dismissed as withdrawn**.
