Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to make the payment of medical reimbursement bills amounting to ₹2,16,202.03/- along-with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that despite the fact that medical reimbursement bills amounting to ₹2,16,202.03/- were submitted by the petitioner on 31.03.2018 in the office of respondent No.3 but till date no action has been taken, except the correspondence in between the Civil Surgeon, Amritsar and the Director Health and Family Welfare, Punjab. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the matter within some time bound manner

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider and decide the case of the petitioner with regard to reimbursement medical bills amounting to ₹2,16,202.03/- within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and also to make the payment thereof, within next one month.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under the law including to approach this Court.
