By virtue of instant writ petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature mandamus directed the respondents to release DCRG to her, as has been given to other similarly situated employees of the same cadre vide Annexures P-12 to P-13, P-13/A along-with interest @18% per annum in view of Judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court rendered in case State of Karnatka vs. C. Lalitha, decided on 31.01.2006 (P-14) with further direction to release balance of arrears of 6th Pay Commission in full w.e.f. 01.01.2006 with interest in view of letter dated 12.01.2011 (P-5).

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner approached the respondents many times by way of submitting representation dated 06.11.2017 (P-15) followed by representation dated 04.04.2018 (P-16) but till date no action has been taken. He further submits

that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said representations within a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, in view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on merit, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents particularly to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representations dated 06.11.2017 and 04.04.2018 (P-15 and P-16) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the order(s) passed by the authority, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
