Petitioner is working as a Technical Assistant with the Department of Forest, Punjab. She is stated to be a permanent resident of Jalandhar. She was transferred from Bist Circle, Jalandhar to the Extension Circle, Mohali vide order dated 26.7.2017 (**P-2**) passed by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Punjab. After one year, she was transferred from the Forest Extension Mohali back to Bist Circle, Jalandhar vide order dated 8.6.2018 (**P-2A**).

The grievance of the petitioner is directed against the order dated 16.7.2018 (**P-6**) whereby, in effect her transfer to Bist Circle, Jalandhar vide P-2 has been cancelled and she posted back to Extension Circle, Mohali.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner , no ground for interference is made out as concededly the petitioner had worked in the

Extension Circle, Mohali for a period of only one year before her transfer back to Jalandhar. Therefore, on cancellation of her transfer from Mohali to Jalandhar as ordered vide order dated 8.6.2018 would not provide a right to the petitioner to assert that she cannot be transferred from Jalandhar without serving there for atleast two years in terms of the Transfer Policy as her stay at Mohali itself is for one year on her transfer in the year 2017.

The further argument sought to be raised qua couple case also is misplaced since this grievance if at all should have been made when she was transferred to Mohali from Jalandhar on 26.7.2017.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present writ petition the same is hereby dismissed.
