AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court with a prayer for issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing respondent No.2-Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ambala, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-5) served upon said respondent in the light of the fact that initially sealing of the shop was based upon their being no valid licence with the petitioner for running a meat shop, which licence has been obtained by it but despite that the respondents have not yet de-sealed the shop.

Counsel thus contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ambala, to consider the legal notice dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner and take a decision thereon,

within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ambala-respondent No.2, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
