The petitioner has prayed for his release on parole for a period of three weeks in terms of Section 3(1)(a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 to attend the last rights including kriya ceremony, which is scheduled to be held on 3.8.2018 in his village, of his father, who died on 24.7.2018.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State has though not filed reply but on verification from Krishan Lal, Jail Warder, Central Jail-I, Hisar, who is present in Court, has accepted that the father of the petitioner has expired and his kriya ceremony is fixed for 03.08.2018.

In view thereof, the present petition is hereby allowed and the petitioner is granted parole for a period of two weeks to attend the

last rites of his father subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate, Hisar.
