MAHESH GROVER, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India where the petitioners pray for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 4 not to implement the resolution dated 01.06.2018.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners, we are of the opinion that the writ is totally frivolous. The issuance of writ of mandamus would depend on a prerequisite of service of demand notice to rectify the resolution or irregularities. No such representation has been made. Except to say that there is a political mala fide in passing the impugned resolution, no meaningful argument has been raised. We are thus of the opinion that firstly the writ of mandamus cannot be issued because the grievance has not been raised before the competent authority and secondly, the petition is premature because the resolution has merely been passed but not

implemented.

Dismissed.
