The petitioner is stated to be serving as a washing boy, a
Class IV Post, posted with Punjab Roadways, Moga.

He has been placed under suspension vide order dated
7.6.2018, Annexure P8; issued a charge sheet dated 20.6.2018 (Annexure
P10),

In the instant petition he has challenged both the
aforesaid orders Annexures P8 and P10.

This Court had issued notice of motion only with regard to the contention that no suspension allowance was being paid.

At the time of resumed hearing today, learned State counsel states that on the complaint of Mangat Singh (Head Mechanic) – respondent No.4, of insubordination, the charge sheet was issued. She further states that after considering the reply to the charge sheet, regular enquiry officer stands appointed. She also states that the petitioner has been reinstated on 25.10.2018, pending the conclusion of the disciplinary proceedings and the admissible suspension allowance stands paid.

In view of the aforesaid developments, no further adjudication is required in the instant writ petition.

Disposed of as having rendered infructuous.
