Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to re-fixation of their pay in view of judgments passed by this Court in CWP Nos. 5563-A/1989 and 16084/1997, which has attained finality with further prayer seeking direction to respondents to restore the deductions made from their payment of additional dearness allowances w.e.f. 01.05.1973 onwards along-with arrears and also to quash the deduction/cut ordered vide offering parts of paragraph 3 and 4 of Annexure P-1 in respect of ad hoc relief allegedly paid in excess.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though legal notice dated 09.05.2018 (P-9) was duly served upon the respondents but till date neither any reply to the afore-said notice has been received nor any conscious

decision has been taken by the respondents. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice dated 09.05.2018 (P-9) in a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated 09.05.2018 (P-9) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid legal notice within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under the law including to approach this Court.
