Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 to 4 has placed on record an order dated 21.11.2018 having endorsement dated 06.12.2018 by which, the respondents have already decided to include the service rendered by the petitioner on daily wage basis while computing the pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for respondents states that even an entry to this fact has already been made in the service book of the petitioner and the calculation has also been done for the relief for which the petitioner is entitled for and the same is pending before the pension department for appropriate orders.

In view of this, the respondents are directed to release the benefits for which the petitioner will become entitle for by re-fixation of his pensionary benefits and release the same within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
