JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to reimburse the medical bills amounting to Rs.91,873/- along with interest.

2. On instructions from Mr. Sanjeev Kumar, Senior Assistant, Civil Surgeon, Hoshiarpur, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the sanction(s) dated 29.04.2015 accorded by the Director, Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, Chandigarh, the medical reimbursement to the tune of Rs.50,474/- has been made to Dr. K.K. Sharma retired Director, Health & Family Welfare.

3. In view of disbursement of the aforesaid payment(s) of medical reimbursement, instant petition has rendered infructuous. Accordingly, it stands disposed of.
4. However, petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court for redressal of his grievance, if any, still aggrieved.
