This application has been filed under Section 151 C.P.C for disposal of the above mentioned appeal in view of the compromise dated 13.11.2017 executed between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

Heard. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the main appeal is taken up today itself.

FAO No.4683-2010

This case along with (FAO No.5584 of 2010) were referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. The matter has been compromised between the parties. As per the compromise, appellants Jaswant Singh and Jarnail Singh in FAO No.4683 of 2010 were directed to handover a demand draft amounting to ₹90,000/- to the learned counsel for respondent-Paramjit

Singh. Learned counsel for the appellants in FAO No.4683 of 2010 has handed over a demand draft amounting to ₹90,000/- bearing No.636749 dated 04.12.2017 to learned counsel for respondent-Paramjit Singh, copy of which is taken on record. It was also agreed that respondent-Paramjit Singh would withdraw the appeal filed by him i.e. FAO No.5584 of 2010.

In view of the compromise, it was also agreed that respondent Paramjit Singh would withdraw the appeal filed by him against acquittal of Jaswant Singh and Jarnail Singh which is pending.

In view of aforesaid, this appeal is disposed of .

The parties would remain bound by the compromise.
