Service of the petitioner was regularized as Gallery Attendant Grade-II w.e.f. 30.06.1997 by the Directorate of Cultural Affairs, Archive and Museum Department, Punjab. The petitioner filed CWP No.4144 of 2012 claiming ante dated date of regularization w.e.f. the date his juniors had been regularized in service. The said writ petition along with a Bunch including CWP No.1514 of 2012 were disposed of by this Court directing the department to decide their claims by passing speaking orders. In Anant Ram's case the Court specifically said that in case the claim is to be accepted the petitioners would be entitled to notional benefits.

The claim of the petitioner, aforesaid Anant Ram and others was decided vide the common order dated 10.12.2012 (P-10) by passing a speaking order, whereby their services were regularized w.e.f. 1991 i.e. the

supernumerary post.

By filing the present writ petition the petitioner is claiming the arrears of salary etc. in compliance of the order P-10.

Counsel for the petitioner heard.

It is conceded that the case of the petitioner was identical to that of the aforesaid Anant Ram whereby retrospective benefits were restricted on notional basis. That apart there is almost a delay of more than six years in filing the present petition thus on both counts i.e. on account of delay and merits, no case for interference is made out.

Dismissed.
