The petitioner is seeking direction to set aside the impugned order passed by learned Permanent Lok Adalat, Public Utility Service, Gurgaon (Haryana) in application No.194 of 2012 decided on 10.06.2013 (Annexure P-1) or any other relief or direction to which the petitioner may be entitled to in the present case.

The dispute in the present case is that petitioner had purchased SIM No.82003870109 with mobile billing No.9873607413 from respondents authorized store but its service has not been activated and on inquiry it was informed to him that services has been de-activated due to credit limit exceeded and unbilled amount was approx. 5,000/-. Petitioner has made application for redressal of his grievance before the Permanent Lok Adalat, Public Utility Services, Gurgaon but vide order dated 10.06.2013, petitioner was ordered to pay a sum of Rs.5491.81/- to the company as outstanding amount and directed the petitioner to go before the civil court and appropriate forum with regard to billing GPRS. Aggrieved against the same, the present writ petition has been filed by him on 12.12.2014. The matter was subsequently adjourned to 17.04.2018 and on that day counsel for the respondents has informed that there is a likelihood of a compromise between the parties.

Today, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the matter has been resolved between the parties and respondent/Company has agreed

to pay Rs.40,000/- to the petitioner within a period of 15 days.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of by giving directions to the respondent/Company to pay Rs.40,000/- to the petitioner within a period of one month.
