After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed that he does not want to contest the present petition on merits as the petitioner is ready and willing to deposit ₹8,000/- to the Haryana School Education Board (for short 'the Board') towards the affiliation fee for Class 8th but it is prayed that the delay, if any, may be condoned by this Court.

Learned counsel for the respondents do not raise any objection in this regard. Consequently, present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to deposit ₹8,000/- with the Board towards affiliation fee of Class 8th within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. It is further ordered that if the aforesaid amount is deposited by the petitioner within the prescribed time then the question of delay and laches be not raised by the Board.
