(1.) Learned counsel for the petitioner furnishes demand draft for a sum of ₹ 6,29,607/- in favour of the respondent-workman towards 17-B wages and it is handed over to learned counsel for the respondent workman.

(2.) In the present petition, petitioner-Management have challenged the orders dated 10.09.2013, 16.12.2013 and 20.11.2014 Annexures P-1, P-2 and P-3, respectively.

(3.) Undisputedly, petitioner was held *ex parte* before the Labour Court which is under challenge in the present petition. Annexures P-1, P-2 and P-3 are set aside. Matter is remanded to the Labour Court. Labour Court is requested to decide Reference No.102/2013 within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Parties are

hereby directed to appear before the Labour Court on 30.05.2018.

Petitioner-Management are liable to pay litigation cost to the respondent-workman to the extent of ₹ 30,000/-. Litigation cost shall be paid within a period of 4 weeks from today.

(4.) Petition stands disposed of.

(5.) At this stage, learned counsel for the respondent-workman pointed out that in the demand draft correct name of the workman is not shown. Therefore, he is directed to return the demand draft to learned counsel for the petitioner. Petitioner is hereby directed to furnish corrected demand draft to the respondent-workman within a period of one week from today.
