By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of interim relief to the petitioners, in view of the order dated February 16, 2017 (P-6) issued by the Government, especially in view of the order dated September 09, 2010 (P-5) along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated December 05, 2017 (P-10) within some stipulated period.

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3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the above said legal notice (P-10) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the order(s) passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
