JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant him promotional benefit of proficiency step-up after considering the length of service after 4, 9 and 14 years respectively and to pay all the arrears of salary, annual increments connected with his post with further direction to revise his pensionary case by calculating the suspension of period of his service w.e.f. 04.08.2005 to 25.01.2008 as duty period.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the representations dated 05.12.2017 and 24.01.2018 (P-2 & P-3) in a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 05.12.2017 (P-2) followed by representaiton dated 24.01.2018 (P-3) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations as well as instructions issued by the government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under the law including to approach this Court.
