By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the quashing of impugned order dated 12.04.2012 (P-6) whereby, person junior to him has been promoted to the post of Personal Assistant with further prayer to direct the respondents to consider his name for promotion to the post of Personal Assistant from deemed date of promotion as Personal Assistant w.e.f. 12.04.2012 on which Sh. D.V. Mahandiratta (junior to him), was promoted as Personal Assistant and also to release the consequential benefits.

2. The contention of learned counsel is that petitioner moved a representation dated 29.12.2016 (P-8) to respondent No.1 but despite the fact that a period of more than 1 ½ year has elapsed neither any response has been

received nor any conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the afore-said representation (P-8) in a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 or any other competent officer, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in their his representation dated 29.12.2016 (P-8) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations as well as notifications issued by the government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under the law including to approach this Court.
