Petitioners have filed the instant writ petition seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to review the process of allocation of seats for Punjab State Civil Services Combined Competitive Examination, 2015 and further make the allocation of seats in consonance with the procedure adopted by the respondents while allocating the seats for Punjab State Civil Services Combined Competitive Examination, 2012 & 2013 wherein the counselling of the selected candidates was conducted before making allocation.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner

submits that the present writ petition has become infructuous since the counselling before allocation of seats as prayed for by the petitioners has been done.
