The petitioner is in District Jail, Rohtak. He is suffering life sentence. He has prayed for his temporary release on furlough for a period of three weeks to meet his family members but his application has been declined by the Commissioner, Rohtak Division, Rohtak on the ground that the petitioner, if released on furlough, may abscond and also commit any crime.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already availed 16 weeks parole in the past and has never absconded. It is also submitted that no other case is pending against him and he is also not involved in any jail offence as well.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is hereby allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on furlough for a period of 3 weeks to meet his family members, subject to his furnishing surety bonds to

the satisfaction of District Magistrate, Charkhi Dadri who may also impose necessary conditions to ensure his return after the period of furlough is over.
