AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents not to change the entries in the revenue records without taking into consideration the fact that there is an injunction in favour of the petitioner passed by the Civil Court and the suit which was preferred by respondent No.5 against him stands dismissed. Highlighting this aspect, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 22.05.2018 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending and no decision thereon has been taken till date.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Sonapat-respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 22.05.2018 (Annexure P-7) submitted by him prior to finalization of the revenue record qua the land in question which has been purchased by the petitioner, who is a *bona fide* purchaser.

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In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with direction to the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Sonapat-respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 22.05.2018 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner prior to carrying out the changes in the revenue record, if already not so done. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
