The petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to quash the practice of relieving him during vacations.

Pursuant to the advertisement dated 01.06.2017 (Annexure P-1), petitioner was appointed as Mali. Copy of appointment letter has been annexed as Annexure P-3. However, the petitioner is being relieved during vacation period. He has been denied the salary for the above said period. Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the judgment passed by this Court in **Anurag Chahal and others vs. State of Haryana and another,** CWP No.16954 of 2015, decided on 05.05.2016 (Annexure P-5), whereby directions have been issued that the contractual employees shall continue to work till regular appointments are made. They have been further held entitled to get salary for the vacation period at the minimum pay scales as admissible to the regular employees. Similar directions have been issued in **Vishwas Sharma vs. State of Haryana and others,** CWP No.14012 of 2018, decided on 30.05.2018 (Annexure P-7).

With regard to his grievance, the petitioner has made a representation dated 14.06.2018 (Annexure P-6) to the respondents, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

At this stage, the present petition is disposed of by giving directions to the respondents to look into the representation dated 14.06.2018 (Annexure P-6) and pass appropriate orders expeditiously, in accordance with law.
