Petitioner has challenged the award passed by the Labour Court dated 27.11.2009 (Annexure P-4).

Petitioner is stated to have been appointed as a Beldar on 2.11.1995 and his services were stated to have been terminated on 31.12.1999. Labour Court after due consideration of the evidence of the respondent-Management found that there is no continuity of service during the period from 1995 to 1999. There were certain breaks. Further it has been recorded that petitioner has left the work on his own in the month of September, 1999. However, petitioner has not produced any contrary documents to show that he was continuously working during the period from 2.11.1995 to 31.12.1999. Moreover, there is a delay in presenting the

present petition since award is dated 27.11.2009, whereas, present writ petition was filed in the month of November, 2013. Thus, petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with the award passed by the Labour Court dated 27.11.2009.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
