This order shall dispose of two petitions bearing CWP No. 188 of 2018 titled as **Gian Bharti High School and others v. The State of Haryana and others** (for short 'the First Petition') and CWP No. 1451 of 2018 titled as **R.K. Senior Secondary School and others v. The State of Haryana and others** (for short 'the Second Petition') as the issue involved in these petitions is common.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has made a request that these writ petitions be converted into representations and the Director, School Education, Government of Haryana, may be directed to decide the same in accordance with law.

In these petitions notice of motion has not been issued but the assistance of the learned State counsel has been sought. The petitioners are basically aggrieved that they have not been granted permanent recognition and are allowed to run their schools with the temporary recognition since long. Their case regarding permanent recognition is allegedly pending with the District Level Committee.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he would be satisfied if the writ petitions, converted into representations, may be decided within a prescribed period by the competent authority i.e. respondent No.2- Director, School Education, Government of Haryana.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petitions are disposed of with the direction to the Director, School Education, Government of Haryana, to decide these writ petitions, converted into representations, on or before 26.3.2018 by passing a speaking order.

Respondent No.2 may take the assistance of petitioners' counsel, if required.
